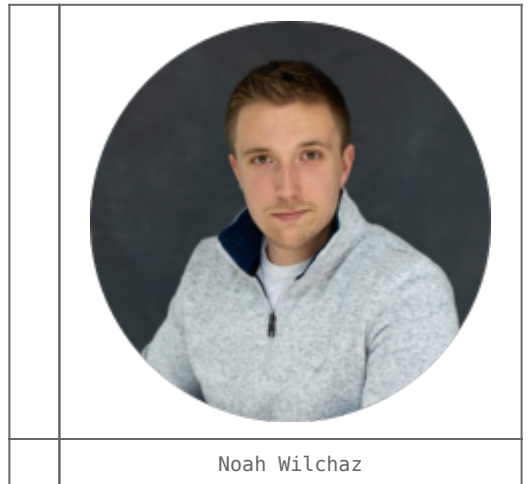


Future 5: Noah Wilchaz
