

AOC Asia 2025 Concludes with Strong Global Participation and Focus on EMSO and AI

More than 450 participants from 17 countries and representing the military, government, academia, industry, and media gathered last week in Seoul, Republic of Korea, for AOC Asia 2025. This year's conference featured a broad series of discussions focused on the latest developments in electromagnetic spectrum operations (EMSO), with particular attention to regional security challenges and the emerging role of artificial intelligence (AI) in shaping future operations.

AOC Asia received outstanding support from the Republic of Korea Air Force (ROKAF), including a keynote address from the ROKAF Chief of Staff and attendance by five former ROKAF Chiefs of Staff at the opening sessions.
